Trail stop 4 – Flora Gardens

Welcome to Flora Gardens estate community pocket garden project!

Flora Gardens is a medium sized estate close to Hammersmith Broadway and Ravenscourt Park, one of our 19 green flag parks in the borough. There's 197 homes on the estate and lots of pockets of green spaces from green roofs to urban drainage solutions.

The Flora Gardens project was completed in 2021 and was developed from the ideas of the Flora Gardens Tenants & Residents Association to transform a non-descript patch of grass into a protected space the community can sit in and get their fingers dirty in the mud.

The project was delivered by our grounds maintenance contractor, Idverde, and the pocket garden will now be maintained by the residents of Flora Gardens for all to enjoy.

DID YOU KNOW...

The origins of Ravenscourt Park lie in the medieval manor and estate of Palingswick (or Paddenswick) Manor, located on the site and first recorded in the 12th century. The historic name still exists today in the name of Paddenswick Road, which runs along the north east. boundary of the park

Next trail stop... Queen Caroline Estate (W6 9EB). Try to take a route through Furnivall Gardens, one of the boroughs 19 green flag parks.
